Comcare	As the national work health and safety (WHS) and workers' compensation authority, Comcare's legislated functions include securing the health and safety of workers and workplaces. Comcare has a workers' compensation role in respect of workplace sexual harassment where that conduct has resulted in an injury or illness to the worker.  Comcare administers the <i>Work Health and Safety Act</i> 2011 (Cth) and Work Health and Safety Regulations 2011 (Cth) and is the national regulator for WHS in the Commonwealth jurisdiction.  Comcare has regulatory functions and powers, including to enforce compliance with WHS laws.
